





Baltic controversy serves as cautionary tale about big development in small towns

Mayor Deborah McIsaac said she was shocked when to comment for this story. she took office in 2022 and discovered a housing development in town had been given the green light without basic paperwork ensuring accountability

"I'm like, 'seriously?" McIsaac said.
